# 2026 Commercial Exhibit Rules, Regulations and Information

### **Exhibit Booth Rules Regulations and Information**

A limited number of commercial exhibit spaces are available in the AES Exhibit Hall at the Chicago Marriott Downtown Magnificent Mile, located in Salon III on the 7th Floor next to the Scientific Sessions Lecture Hall. All fees must be paid in full prior to the meeting. Each 8'x10' booth includes pipe and drape, an ID sign, one six-foot table, two chairs, and one high-rise presentation table. The fee also covers breakfast, lunch, and the President's Reception for two registered representative on both exhibit days, including Wednesday evening. Additional representatives may register for \$550 each. Exhibitors are responsible for ordering electrical hookups of 10 or more amps with the AV Company. Wi-Fi is provided at no extra cost.

### **Exhibit Booth Rules Regulations and Information**

AES reserves the right to refuse any commercial display deemed inappropriate for the scientific nature of the meeting. First-time exhibitors must be approved, and materials may only be distributed at the exhibitor's booth. All exhibit materials must comply with local fire laws, insurance underwriter, and safety regulations. Flammable or explosive substances are prohibited, and all electrical work must meet local codes. Exhibitors must remove packing materials before the hall opens and must staff their booths during all exhibit hours. The hotel will secure the exhibit hall after hours; however, AES does not insure exhibitor property for loss, theft, damage, or breakage. Neither AES nor the hotel is responsible for injury or damage to persons or property. Exhibitors are liable for any damages caused by their actions. No refunds will be issued for no-shows. Cancellations made up to eight weeks before the event will receive a 50% refund; no refunds will be given after that point. Exhibitors shipping materials directly to the hotel must notify the AES office in advance. Additional exhibitor information and registration kits will be provided at a later date.
